<u>Chairman Marshall</u>: Good morning, everyone. My name is Delegate Danny Marshall. I am now calling the Incentives and Loans Committee meeting to order.

Acting Director Campos: This all-virtual meeting of the TRRC Incentives and Loans Committee has been called for at the request of the Commission Chairman Danny Marshall and was authorized in accordance with the Commission's adopted policy for all-virtual public meetings. Furthermore, the Commission notes the meeting has complied with the requirements of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act.

<u>Chairman Marshall</u>: Thank you, James. Alright let's call the role please.

The subject of this closed session is for the discussion of possible incentives for a Project considering a location in the Commission's footprint. The applicable exemption from open meeting requirements under the Freedom of Information Act is § 2.2-3711(A)(39).

The recommendation is subject to the conditions described by staff and the Commission entering into a customary loan agreement containing appropriate performance, clawback and security provisions as necessary.
